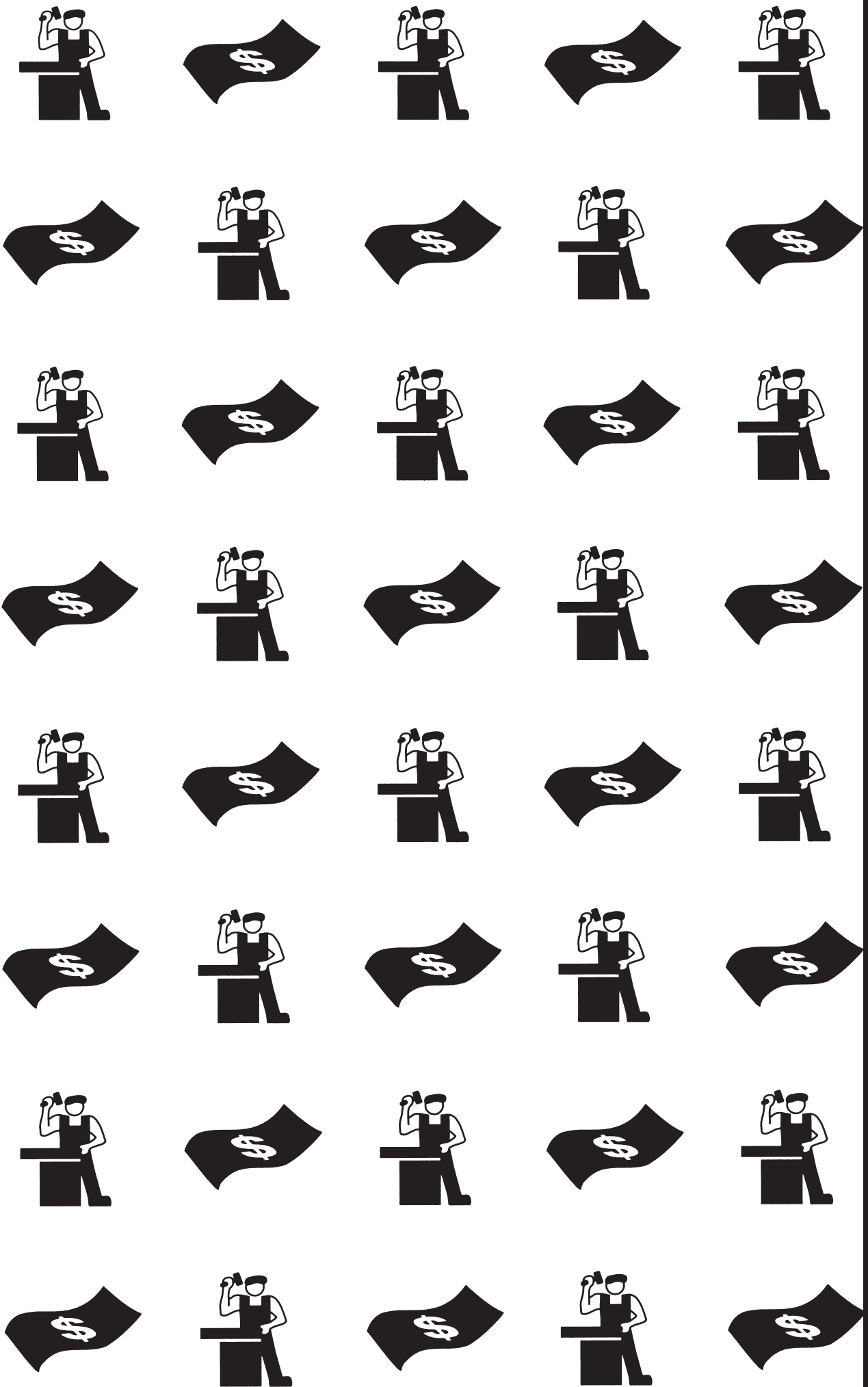


# Finance & Labor



## Section 9

### FINANCE & LABOR

Part one of this section presents statistics on the financial institutions on Hawai'i Island. Part two includes figures for Hawai'i County's labor force.

The civilian labor force for 2015 was 87,050 and the number of employed was 83,000. The unemployment rate has continuously decreased since 2009 to reach 4.6% in 2015, the lowest level since 2007. In all the counties in the state, unemployment rates were under 5% in 2015.

Data for this section came from many sources, including the Hawai'i State Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism and the Hawai'i Department of Industrial Labor and Relations.
