# Hawai'i State Procurement Office Launches Small Business Initiative



Small Business Week is just around the corner, May 5, 2019 - May 11, 2019, and the Hawai'i State Procurement Office would like to formally announce the launching of the Small Business Initiative.

The Small Business Initiative was established by Act 42 (SLH 2017) to ensure that small businesses, especially those owned by Veterans, Native Hawaiians, and Women, are able to effectively participate in contracting opportunities within the State of Hawai'i. The Small Business Initiative supports the Small Business Database and Small Business Office.

The State of Hawai'i is one of the largest consumers of goods, services, and construction and provides opportunities for businesses of all levels to contract with them. Small Business owners are encouraged to see if their business qualifies and register in the Hawai'i Small Business Database.

By registering as a small business, buyers and other interested vendors will be able to identify small businesses in the State. The process to register is simple- there is a registration wizard that guides registrants

### Hawai'i SBDC Fully Accredited by America's Small Business Development Centers

One of the distinguishing factors of all nationwide SBDC programs is the required accreditation every 5 years by a rigorous process established under federal laws, and administered by the ASBDC. This process



includes the creation of a self-study document and a 4-day onsite audit by members of the Accreditation Committee. Any deficiencies or issues must be satisfactorily addressed within a designated period of time for full accreditation to be awarded.

Having again been fully accredited, the Hawaiʻi SBDC is authorized to display the "Accredited Member" logo.

SBDCs are hosted by leading universities, colleges, state economic development agencies and private sector partners, and funded in part by the United States Congress through a partnership with the U.S. Small Business Administration.

## PRTC: Patent and Trademark Resource Center at the Hawai'i State Library



Have a great idea for an invention or product? Need to find out how to protect your intellectual property (IP)? Start with a patent or trademark search to see if someone already has IP rights for the same idea. You can

conduct your preliminary search at the Hawai'i State Library's Patent and Trademark Resource Center.

The PTRC is located on the 2nd floor of the Hawai'i State Library, within the Federal Documents Section. Resources and Services include:

- One computer dedicated to patent and trademark searching
- Specialized reference services for patents, trademarks and copyrights
- Training on preliminary patent searching
- IP seminars on patents, trademarks and copyrights
- Free access to patent and trademark databases PubEAST and PubWEST
- Collection of full-color patents in print
- Collection of books on IP
