## New Funding for Technology Product Development

Product Development Funding is now available to companies that are creating new products that involve intensive research and development. During the 2015 legislative session 3 programs were passed into law to help Hawai'i technology companies obtain early stage commercial funding for development. The **HISBIR** program was expanded provide up to 50% match to a maximum of \$500,000 for companies receiving Federal Small **Business** Innovation and Phase 3. This is the critical phase for companies as they advance their technology from prototype to a marketable product. Companies must have already received the federal award.

## Hawai'i SBDC Success Story: Manakoa Gym

When Ralph, Cynthia and Sarah first came to the Hawai'i SBDC, all they had was a dream to move from California to Hawai'i to start a recreational gymnastics



center incorporating children's learning. Ralph and Cynthia are retired school teachers and Sarah, their daughter, was a collegiate gymnast and a member of the Junior Olympic Program.

They had the skill sets to run the gymnastics programs but still had much to learn about starting a business in Hawaii. Over the course of a year, we were able to assist Manakoa Gym with market research and local knowledge on inventory of available commercial spaces. Being their first business in a new market, it was particularly challenging to secure financing for their venture. Through hard work and persistence, we helped them to complete their business plan, which included financial projections. Manakoa received an SBA guaranteed loan as a result. We continue to work together in creating viable marketing strategies to ensure their continued success.

## Research Grants (SBIR) Phase 2 ExporTech™ Comes to Hawai'i

The Hawai'i SBDC Oʻahu Office is collaborating with the Hawai'i Pacific Export Council and Innovate Hawai'i to bring ExporTech™ to Hawai'i for the



first time. This effort is supported by the SBA STEP Grant. ExporTech™ is

The program is administered by the HTDC. The application process is simple. The application can be found online at www.htdc.org. Once the application is processed, the company must present the project to an ad hoc review committee and then to the HTDC Board's Federal **Projects** Committee which determines the amount of match funding a company will receive. HTDC board of directors makes the final approval.

The advantage of this program is **Initiative** that the decision to fund is made within 8 weeks from time of The Hawai'i SBDC, in partnership with application. Funding can be used supplement the federal funding to purchase items or hire grant.

A similar program HONR, provides matching grant funds to companies that are conducting energy research projects funded with an Office of Naval Research contract. The funding limits are similar, 50% match up to \$500,000. Applications and more information can be found on the HTDC website.

people not provided by the SBIR We are increasing business capacity for one client in two specific ways. First, by expanding to a second location on O'ahu. A potential site is in the planning phase as we work through demographic and cost analyses. Second, we are creating an online presence and beginning to sell items for direct purchase, both wholesale and retail. We completed a marketing analysis, and their business plan is in progress along with an overall strategic plan.

> Once these plans are completed, our effort will focus on helping the client to pursue financing for these new efforts. This client is not waiting for their situation to deteriorate further, and is taking advantage of the free, on site business advisory services offered by the O'ahu office of the Hawai'i SBDC.
