# Kaua'i Island's <u>Lydgate Farms</u> Pivots to Online Marketing Model

Lydgate Farms on the island of Kaua'i in Hawai'i is a grower of highquality cacao, from which they produce award-winning artisan chocolate products and and array of other small-batch, single origin, value-added

agricultural products such as vanilla beans and wild honey among others. Pre-pandemic, Will Lydgate, the founder and CEO and 5th generation Kaua'i farmer, was executing a growth plan, which was created with the ongoing support of the Hawai'i SBDC. The plan included vertical integration, acquisition of additional orchard land, and an export effort, starting with Japan.



But when the state shut down the visitor industry, suddenly the viability of the

businesss was threatened due to the lack of tourists, who previously made up the majority of Lydgate's customers. Starting in March of 2020, there were no visitors participating in the popular farm tour, chocolate tasting activities, and making gift shop purchases. These popular activities were a significant source of pre-pandemic revenue which were immediately cut off, making the continuation of cacao cultivation and production operations difficult at best.

With the assistance of the Hawai'i SBDC, Lydgate developed a strategic outline for navigating through the crisis. He immediately shifted his focus internally, making sure that his staff of five was taken care of through SBA assistance programs such as the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) and the Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL). The Hawai'i SBDC provided guidance on the application process, and later on how to achieve maximum PPP forgiveness. Expenses were cut significantly.

At the same time, Lydgate revamped his online marketing, which included suggestions from the Hawai'i SBDC on renewing the product mix, refining the associated online marketing campaign, and reorganizing

the website. He created a custom shipping box for protecting products from high temperatures.

Adding virtual farm tours and limited offerings have increased site visits and online purchases. Although revenue and net profit was serioulsy eroded during the period from March through May, the SBA relief funds have allowed operations to continue, although at a reduced scale. June was an inflection point where it appears the situation has stabilized, and if the state opens up to tourists on September 1, 2020 as scheduled, Lydgate Farms looks forward to again welcoming

Loan visitors to participate in their unique, social-distancing and educational farm tours and chocolate tasting activities.

When sales revenue is re-established with some consistency, the focus will include reviving the export component of the growth plan by participating in the HISTEP Grant (Hawai'i SBA SREP Grant) to identify and create export opportunities. HISTEP program elements consist of Export Readiness Assistance, Company Assistance and Hawai'i Pavilions. The Hawai'i SBDC will be ready to assist in this effort, contributing to the long-term viability of the company, preserving and expanding jobs, and supporting the emergent craft chocolate industry in Hawai'i.
